Rules and Expectations Contract

Bus

Keep voices to a reasonable speaking level. No shouting or yelling.

Movies must be approved by the directors. No "R" rated movies will be allowed.

You may bring snacks/drinks on the bus.

Pick up the floor of the bus on a regular basis and dispose of trash in the appropriate trash containers.

"Band couples" may sit together but only in the first three rows of seats. Beyond the front rows, guys sit with guys, and girls sit with girls.

All students will help load and unload bus of baggage and equipment when necessary.

Say "please" and "thank-you" often while on this trip - especially to the bus driver and travel rep when you disembark the bus.

Hotel

Pool and lobby areas are great gathering places. Girls and Boys may congregate in CPU hotel rooms until the designated "In Your Rooms" time. There must be at least three students in a room and doors must be wide open.

No student may leave their hotel room after the designated "In Your Rooms" time. No exceptions. If you must contact the Jacobi's, please do so using your room phone.

At "In Your Rooms" time, every room will be checked for attendance.

Any damage, vandalism, or theft from the hotel will be dealt with according to the school district Good Conduct Policy.

Hotel security will be present from 10:00pm to 6:00am each night we are at the hotel.

Attire

Check the weather forecast prior to our departure to determine what type of layers you will need. Be prepared for rain.

Bus travel clothing **Thursday and Friday** morning should be comfortable. However, please have available nice pants, khakis, nice shirt/blouse and jacket for our performance on the INTREPID Friday afternoon.

Saturday includes a wide variety of activities that require flexibility in clothing for the day. Once we leave in the AM, we will not be returning to the hotel until late evening. That being said, the following dress requirements for Saturday are:

- Nice pants such as dress pants or khakis - NO JEANS

- Nice blouse, shirt or polo - no t-shirts

- Comfortable walking shoes for the day

- Dress shoes for the evening

- Light jacket in case of inclement weather

**You may bring a small bag for clothing changes you may wish to make. You will have bus access in between activities.*

Sunday we will be touring the 9/11 Memorial. Please be dressed in a respectful manner. You will want to have a set of comfortable clothes on the bus for the trip home later that evening.

Odds and Ends

If parents need to contact us, they may email our school address (we have it synced to our phones,) contact the school and they will call us, or they may contact the hotel or emergency number for Bob Roger's Travel.

They can log in as guests to the Bob Rogers App and follow our trip to NYC.

Get an advance make-up completed for blocks 3 and 4 on Thursday and all of Friday.

A small 'weekend bag' suitcase or duffle bag is an appropriate size bag.

WiFi is available on the bus, however, it is REALLY SLOW. Bring your own charger as only one side of the bus has outlets.

The itinerary is final. Do not ask for additions or changes at any time & do be flexible with any required changes due to unforeseen circumstances.

Public displays of affection are not acceptable at any time. This is a school sponsored trip, and you are expected to conduct yourself accordingly.

Have spending cash or debit card with you for souvenirs and other miscellaneous items & keep secured closely to your person.

Students are required to be in groups of 3 or more CPU students and one adult chaperone at all times unless otherwise directed.

Students are expected to wear clothing that identifies them from CPU and/or carry the BRT drawstring bag.

Seven meals are the responsibility of travelers: 2 meals going to NYC, 3 lunches (Fri, Sat, Sun) and 2 meals on the return trip to Iowa. Expect to pay \$10 per meal to and from NYC and \$15 for lunch in the city.

Be respectful of others and all facilities and equipment throughout the trip. Conduct yourself and treat everyone in a way that our hosts extend a return invitation. Represent yourself and the Center Point-Urbana community with pride and respect. “Please” and “Thank You” go a long way.

Students must adhere to the CPU High School Good Conduct Policy at all times while on the trip. Not doing so will be dealt with by Mr. and Mrs Jacobi and Mr Libolt and may include limiting your interactions or activities for the remainder of the trip or even being sent home at your expense. Disciplinary action may continue upon our return to CPU.
